
LA SIERRAZUELA

ABOUT

La Sierrazuela is a working cortijo surrounded by 600 ancient olive trees, located just outside Arcos de la Frontera in the province of Cádiz. Built in 1750 and repurposed in 2023 by Igor Ramírez García-Peralta—writer, journalist director, and athlete—it's a place rooted in land, light, and rhythm. After years in places like Ibiza, Milan, Vienna, London and Madrid, Igor relocated to Andalucía to build something slower and more intentional: a home with animals, oil, firewood, and meaning.

Ideally situated between the Atlantic coast and the white villages of the Sierra, La Sierrazuela offers rare access to both raw nature and cultural heritage—making it a discreet but powerful base for film, photo, and editorial projects.


Closest airports are Jeréz (20'), Sevilla and Gibraltar (both just over an hour away).


ARCOS DE LA FRONTERA

Hilltop white town with Moorish arches, narrow streets, sandstone cliffs




JEREZ DE LA FRONTERA

Historic seaside town, Doñana views, seafood markets, faded palaces





CÁDIZ

Pristine white village on a ridge, stylish but traditional




MEDINA SIDONIA

Lesser known towns with sierras, reservoirs, rural authenticity





COSTA DE LA LUZ

Wild beaches, dunes, pine forests




EL PALMAR

Long, undeveloped surf beach with golden light, pine forests and laidback nightlife




BOLONIA

More built-up, long promenade, western sunsets






